Навчально-методичні рекомендації розроблені відповідно навчального плану. До складу методичних рекомендацій входять навчальна програма, теми практичних занять та самостійної роботи здобувачів. Матеріали призначено для здобувачів вищої освіти факультету кібербезпеки, програмної інженерії та комп'ютерних наук Міжнародного гуманітарного університету.

Дисципліна «Іноземна мова», яка є обов'язковою компонентою освітньо-професійної програми «Інженерія програмного забезпечення», спрямована на підготовку спеціалістів, які демонструють комунікативну компетенцію на рівні B2 у всіх видах мовленнєвої діяльності (читанні, говорінні, аудіюванні та письмі), і котрі здатні досягати порозуміння зі співрозмовниками і обговорювати широке коло питань, пов'язаних зі спеціалізацією; готувати публічні виступи з фахових питань, застосовуючи відповідні засоби вербальної комунікації та адекватні форми ведення дискусій і дебатів; знаходити нову текстову, графічну, аудіо та відео інформацію, що міститься в англomовних галузевих матеріалах (як у друкованому, так і в електронному вигляді), користуючись відповідними пошуковими методами і термінологією; аналізувати англomовні джерела інформації для отримання даних, що є необхідними для виконання професійних завдань та прийняття професійних рішень; вести ділове листування, демонструючи міжкультурне порозуміння; перекладати англomовні професійні тексти на рідну мову, користуючись двомовними термінологічними словниками, електронними словниками та програмним забезпеченням перекладацького спрямування.

Placement Test

The *Speakout* Placement Test is designed as a diagnostic tool for use at the beginning of a course. It will help the teacher to place students at the correct level in groups of similar ability and/or to decide what pace and approach to adopt.

The test has a multiple-choice format of 200 questions and covers the grammatical structures and vocabulary in the six levels of *Speakout*.

If you have some idea of your students' level, you could direct them to answer specific parts of the test.

Suggested entry points are:

- For Starter and Elementary level students, questions 1–50
- For Pre-intermediate level students, questions 51–100
- For Intermediate level students, questions 101–150
- For Upper Intermediate and Advanced level students, questions 150–200

Scoring and placement

- 0–15 = Starter level
- 15–30 = Elementary Unit 1
- 31–50 = Elementary Unit 7
- 51–75 = Pre-intermediate Unit 1
- 76–100 = Pre-intermediate Unit 7
- 101–125 = Intermediate Unit 1
- 126–150 = Intermediate Unit 6
- 151–170 = Upper Intermediate Unit 1
- 171–185 = Upper Intermediate Unit 6
- 186+ = Advanced level

It is important to note that the placement test is **not** designed to test listening, speaking or writing skills. A short oral interview, alone or in pairs, would give you a more realistic picture of the learners' communicative ability and help you decide if he/she should be placed at a slightly higher or lower level than that indicated by the placement test. If feasible, a short piece of writing would also help your final evaluation.
